At about the time of the above date (1863) B. S. Jones was elected Church Clerk
of afore said Church, and continued to be Clerk till June 23rd 1888.
at which time he was authorized by a vote of the Church
to transfer the names of the present membership to a
new book. This book was then purchased, for said purpose.
And he as the abiding Clerk proceed to make the afore
said transfer as set forth in the order indicated in
the following pages.

Ray Thompson was elected a trustee for a term of two years on a motion by Millie Thompson and seconded by Renal Riley.

November 4, 1951 (Cont'd)

A motion made by Millie Thompson and seconded by Perry Scott to elect Charles Walker trustee for three years was carried. Martha Jane Wagner was elected church clerk on a motion by Harvey Thompson, seconded by Perry Scott.

Perry Scott nominated Mina Scott church treasurer. Harvey Thompson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Millie Thompson was elected church pianist on a motion by Perry Scott, seconded by Mrs. Harvey Thompson. Marjorie Mercer Culp was elected assistant pianist on a motion by Mrs. Charles Walker seconded by Renal Riley.

Mrs. Renal Riley nominated Mrs. Mary Boyd and Mrs. Jentru Odle as church reporters for the following year. Millie Thompson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The business of the meeting being finished, the meeting adjourned.

Reverend Floyd Miller called to order an afternoon business meeting of the Mt. Joy Christian Church.

A motion to install Rev. Miller as chairman of the meeting was made by Millie Thompson and seconded by Ray Thompson.

The minutes of the last meeting were read by the clerk, Martha Jane Wagner.

The chairman asked for nominations for the offices of church trustees. Pearl Riley nominated Vern McBride to succeed himself as trustee for one year. Perry Scott seconded the motion which carried.

The term of trustee for two years was voted to Artie Thompson on a motion by Harvey Thompson.

Ray Thompson was elected trustee for the three year term on a motion made by Perry Scott.

There followed the election of the trustees, a discussion of the length of office for deacons, deaconesses, and church clerk.

Martha Jane Wagner made a motion that the deacons and deaconesses retain their offices as long as their facilities and morals remain in accordance with the needs of their offices. Ruth Scott seconded the motion.

which carried by voice vote.

Harvey Thompson moved that the church clerk remain in office for a term of five years. Pearl Riley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion to elect Sara Scott and Ruth Scott church reporters was made by Martha Jane Wagner and seconded by Clarice Thompson. Motion carried.

A motion to elect Millie Thompson church pianist was made by Ruth Scott, seconded by Perry Scott. Motion carried.

Mrs. Nellie Walker nominated Mrs. Dell Riley to serve as assistant church pianist. Hazel and Helen Brown were also encouraged to serve as assistant pianists. Ruth Scott seconded the motion which carried.

Pearl Riley, the elected chairman of the deacons and deaconesses, made a report of their deliberations which included the following matters: a form letter approved concerning the membership standing of absent and inactive members; a campaign to enlist community residents and inactive church members to attend the planned church revival to be held the last week of April through the first week of May; the expenses of the revival such as

fees for the minister, assistant leader and janitor, to be paid by the nightly collections; a series of cottage prayer meetings to be held for the success of the revival. The chairman Rev. Miller asked for a motion that the deacons and deaconesses report be accepted. The motion made by Renal Riley carried.

During the discussion of the above report, Marion Thompson, Thirza Brown, Ruth Scott and Sara Scott were named as members of a committee to advertise the revival services.

Ray Thompson the lone trustee present reported and commented on suggestions of the minister to plan the following improvements: new pews, building insulation, a better heating system. Half or full basement, a lighted recreation area, needed roof repairs. During the house discussion which followed, a church well and the enclosing of the vestibule were suggested as improvements. Perry Scott made a motion for the trustees to consider together the above items and

later make a report of suggestions to the corporate body. The motion passed.

The national building loan fund goal and its purpose were considered.

Approval of the fund pledge were left to be decided after more information concerning it could be secured.

A motion for adjournment was then made by Perry Scott, seconded by Ray Thompson and carried.

On Article VI, Section VII. A quorum shall consist
of 20% of active membership lists. The
motion made by Perry Scott, seconded by
Dell Riley, carried.

On Article VII. Martha Wagner moved that a
minister may be hired for one year. The
motion, seconded by Aubrey Jones, carried.

In Section II, A protest clerk may be appointed
to record the minutes by the chairman
in the absence of the regular clerk. Motion
made by Sam Scott, seconded by Dell Riley -
carried.

The adoption of the Constitution as amended
was adopted on a motion by Dell Riley,
seconded by Perry Scott. There being eleven
members present in good standing, after
this meeting had been duly announced well
in advance, the voting by ballot was as
follows: 7 yeas; 1 No; 2 blanks.

Aubrey Jones made a motion that Perry Scott
have copies of the amended Constitution made.
Motion seconded by Sam Scott. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Aubrey
Jones and seconded by Harvey Thompson.
