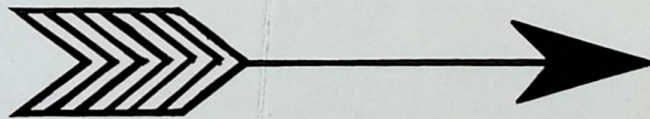


Happening
