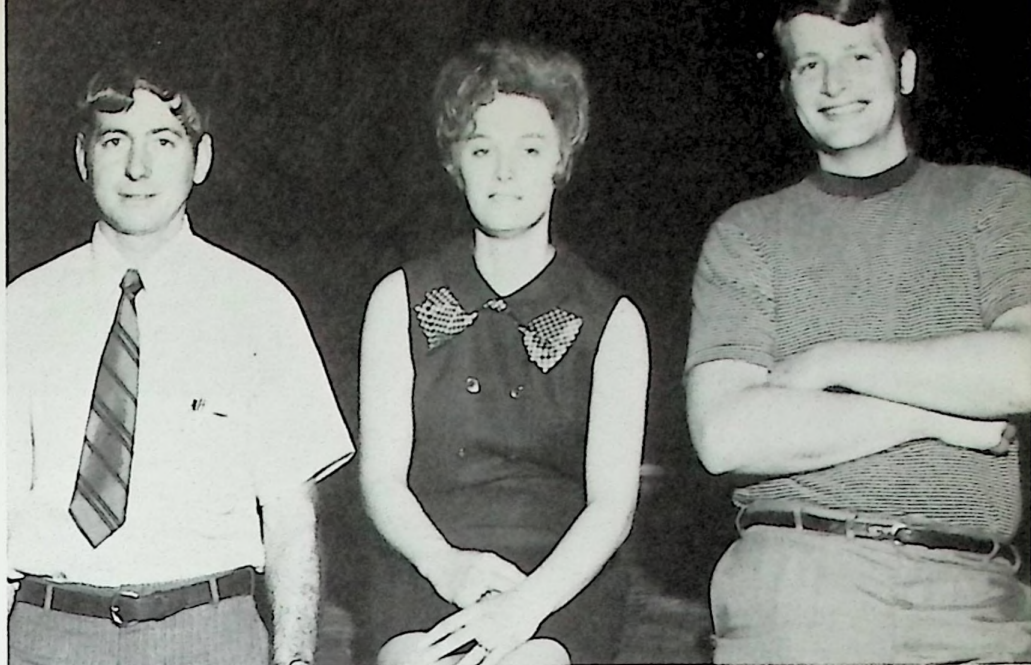
Social Sciences
